Three hours drive from Phnom Penh, Pursat holds some unique bird species not seen in other locations in Cambodia. Chinese Grassbird and Yellow-breasted Bunting are but a few of the spectacular species that the grasslands of Pursat is home to. For two days of easy birding from Phnom Penh, this tour is for you.

DAY 1: PHNOM PENH TO PURSAT GRASSLANDS

08:00 – Departure at about from the hotel after breakfast.

It takes about 3/4 hours to get to Pursat province.

12:00 – Lunch in Pursat province.

After arrival, there'll be a short break in the hotel after lunch and we will go birding in late afternoon.

14:30 – Birding in the Bakan Grasslands

We will be looking for Chinese Grassbird, Yellow-breasted Bunting, Eastern Marsh Harrier, Pied Harrier, Bluethroat, Oriental Skylark, Striated Grassbird, Red Avadavat and other grassland bird species.

17:00 – Go to the hotel, dinner and night in Pursat town.

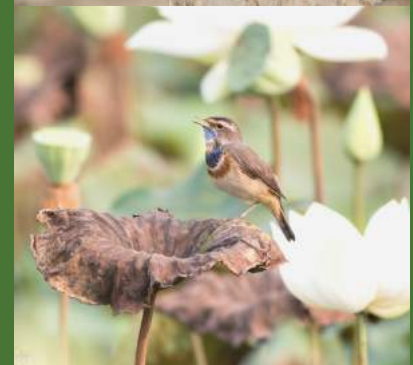

Seasonally flooded tall inner-floodplain grassland with some areas of scrub and agricultural land.



DAY 2: PURSAT GRASSLANDS TO PHNOM PENH

04:30 – Leave the hotel in Pursat

It is about a 2 hour trip from Pursat town to Bakan Grassland. A prepared breakfast, tea & coffee will be provided when we arrive at the birding spot.

06:30 – Birding at Pursat/Bakan Grassland Areas

Our guides have a very good track record of finding Critically-Endangered birds. This includes Chinese Grassbird, Yellow-breasted Bunting, Storks, Black-browed and Oriental Reed-warbler, Pied and Eastern Marsh Harrier, Small Buttonquail, Bluethroat and Red Avadavat; and also some other missing bird species which we did not see on our first afternoon.

10:00 – Leave the grassland and back to the hotel- Pursat town.

Lunch and then return to Phnom Penh.
