PHNOM PENH CAMBODIAN TAILORBIRD MORNING TOUR



Join SVC Tours for a half day of birding in Phnom Penh.

This tour is a perfect introduction to birding in Cambodia. Our Khmer, English-speaking guides are the best birding and wildlife guides in Cambodia. Let them take you on a journey to discover a world of birds you never knew existed just outside of Phnom Penh city.

The highlight of this trip is viewing a bird species that is seen no where else on the planet- Cambodian Tailorbird.

DAY 1: PHNOM PENH TO CAMBODIAN TAILORBIRD SITE

5:30AM: Pick up from your location in Phnom Penh or meet at Farm to Table

6:15AM: Arrive at Skyland 7NG area.

We will have a look around the vegetation, as Cambodia Tailorbird, the newly identified endemic species in 2013. This landscape consists of many different habitats, starting from rice fields, trapeangs, scrubs and vegetation which allow us to see many different species of birds, such as Greater Coucal, Blue-tailed Bee-eater, Indian Spot-billed Duck, Red-wattled Lapwing, and many others smaller birds from this vast area.

6:45AM: Breakfast.

We will find a comfortable place to have our lovely breakfast provided by Farm to Table plus coffee and tea and learn about Sam Veasna Conservation Tours background and our goals. This is also an excellent opportunity to see a variety of birds flying around us.

7:15AM: Continue exploring the 7NG Skyland site.

9:00AM: Drive to Wat Pech Makod.

This is a very easy place to get Cambodian Tailorbird, plus many more species; such as Green-billed Malkoha, Abbot's Babbler, Asian Paradise Flycatcher, and occasionally we have seen the Blue-winged Pitta, and the Hooded Pitta.

10:30AM: Depart for Phnom Penh

Check the checklist and head back to the vehicle to have a cold drink then straight to the ferry and back to Phnom Penh.

11:00AM: Arrive back in Phnom Penh. Farm to Table for brunch is chosen as optional extra.



Drive Time:

1 hour

Walking Distance:

2-3km

Key Species:

Cambodian Tailorbird, Watercock, Black Bittern, Oriental Darter, Plain-backed Sparrow, Siberian Rubythroat, Forest Wagtail, Painted Stork, Black-headed Ibis

Habitat:

Seasonally inundated outer-floodplain grassland with some small areas of scrub.
